

HealthRx Module Roles



PI-Dashboard (Animal/Biological/Chemical/Radiation)

Biological/Chemical/Radiation Safety Officer: May review, comment, and approve ALL submitted registrations and may send registrations to or approve on behalf of IBC.

IBC/IRB Member: May review, comment, and approve only registrations that have been delegated by the BSO.

Principal Investigator: Restricted access to registrations and amendments that are associated with an individual PI. May create, amend, and submit registrations for approval.

Safety Specialist: May access submitted registration information and leave comments for reviewers and PI.

***Proxy:** PIs may delegate tasks to associated lab members (PI review required prior to submission)



Inventory Manager

Administrator: Track and monitor inventory from request to disposal and adjust inventory catalogues, training and events requirements, and inventory records.

Approver: View, approve, order, and send inventory requests to laboratories.

Disposer: View and monitor inventory disposal requests and assign pickup dates.

User: May access only records associated to their account and may request new inventory and disposal pickups.

Warehouse: Track and monitor inventory quantities and order or send inventory requests to a lab.

***Proxy:** PIs may delegate tasks to associated lab members (PI review required prior to submission)



Workplace Injury and Illness Manager

Administrator: View and assign injury and illness investigations to organizationally assigned safety specialists. Upon completion, administrators may close out injury and illness investigations.

Safety Specialist: View and respond to only assigned injury investigations.



Medical Surveillance Manager

Administrator: Create, remove, and update EMR records, assign tasks the healthcare providers and safety specialists, and track productivity and safety metrics with analytical reports.

Healthcare Provider: Create and update patient records and download general reports.

Staff: Patient data is read only and users are only able to download institutionally permitted patient documentation.



Laboratory Safety Manager

Manager: Access all laboratory, inspection, and deficiency data within the entire institution and update available inspection surveys.

Principal Investigator: Respond to assigned deficiencies in laboratories they have registered research. PIs may submit laboratory clearance requests.

Safety Specialist: May conduct, monitor, and finalize inspections in laboratories to which they are permitted access. May also submit, finalize, and conduct laboratory clearances

***Proxy:** PIs may delegate tasks to associated lab members (PI review required prior to submission)



Clinical Access Manager

Administrator: Create, remove, and update any record and view productivity and other analytical reports.

Healthcare Provider: May create, update, and remove appointments individual appointments and request equipment and materials needed for specific appointments.

Staff: May create, update, and remove appointments for healthcare providers and may print schedules and productivity reports.



Vaccine Manager

Administrator: Access the mobile flu application to quickly capture patient information for mass immunizations. Track and monitor vaccine inventories, immunization compliance, and access a large library of reports.

User: Exclusively view patient information and download immunization documentation belonging to the logged in user.



Data Analytics

User: Can create and configure personal reports with data from modules in which they are granted access.

Administrator: Can create and maintain institutionally available reports.
